Latham<sup>®</sup> LH 8101 was developed as an introductory 101-style alfalfa product for short rotations. Consistent across both dry and heavy wet soils this alfalfa packs a heavy punch against bacterial wilt with good performance against other common pathogens. 3 cuttings per season are recommended as this variety needs the late-season growth for overwintering. Overall this variety provides excellent value for standard alfalfa.
